Fasting and Abstinence

All Catholics 18 to 60 are required to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. This means no eating between meals and eating only one meal.

All Catholics from their 14th birthday must abstain from meat on all Fridays of Lent as well as on Ash Wednesday.
